















Care Symbol	Written Care Instructions	What Care Symbol and Instructions Mean
<b>Wash</b>		
	<b>Machine Wash, Normal</b>	Garment may be laundered through the use of hottest available water, detergent or soap, agitation, and a machine designed for this purpose.
	<b>Machine Wash, Cold</b>	Initial water temperature should not exceed 30C or 65 to 85F.
	<b>Machine Wash, Warm</b>	Initial water temperature should not exceed 40C or 105F.
	<b>Machine Wash, Hot</b>	Initial water temperature should not exceed 50C or 120F.
	<b>Machine Wash, Hot</b>	Initial water temperature should not exceed 60C or 140F.
	<b>Machine Wash, Hot</b>	Initial water temperature should not exceed 70C or 160F.
	<b>Machine Wash, Hot</b>	Initial water temperature should not exceed 95C or 200F.
<b>NOTE: SYSTEM OF DOTS INDICATING TEMPERATURE RANGE IS THE SAME FOR ALL WASH PROCEDURES.</b>		
	<b>Machine Wash, Permanent Press</b>	Garment may be machine laundered only on the setting designed to preserve Permanent Press with cool down or cold rinse prior to reduced spin.






	<b>Machine Wash, Gentle or Delicate</b>	Garment may be machine laundered only on the setting designed for gentle agitation and/or reduced time for delicate items.
	<b>Hand Wash</b>	Garment may be laundered through the use of water, detergent or soap and gentle hand manipulation.
	<b>Do Not Wash</b>	Garment may not be safely laundered by any process. Normally accompanied by Dry Clean instructions.

### Bleach


**NOTE:** All (98+%) washable textiles are safe in some type of bleach. IF BLEACH IS NOT MENTIONED OR REPRESENTED BY A SYMBOL, ANY BLEACH MAY BE USED.

	<b>Bleach When Needed</b>	Any commercially available bleach product may be used in the laundering process.
	<b>Non-Chlorine Bleach When Needed</b>	Only a non-chlorine, color-safe bleach may be used in the laundering process. Chlorine bleach may not be used.
	<b>Do Not Bleach</b>	No bleach product may be used. The garment is not colorfast or structurally able to withstand any bleach.

### Dry










	<b>Tumble Dry, Normal</b>	A machine dryer may be regularly used at the hottest available temperature setting.
	<b>Tumble Dry, Normal, Low Heat</b>	A machine dryer may be regularly used at a maximum of Low Heat setting.
	<b>Tumble Dry, Normal, Medium Heat</b>	A machine dryer may be regularly used at a maximum of Medium Heat setting.
	<b>Tumble Dry, Normal, High Heat</b>	A machine dryer may be regularly used at a High Heat setting.
	<b>Tumble Dry, Normal, No Heat</b>	A machine dryer may be regularly used only at No Heat or Air Only setting.

**NOTE:** SYSTEM OF DOTS INDICATING TEMPERATURE RANGE IS THE SAME FOR ALL DRY PROCEDURES.

	<b>Tumble Dry, Permanent Press</b>	A machine dryer may be regularly used only at the Permanent Press setting.
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	<b>Tumble Dry, Gentle</b>	A machine dryer may be regularly used only at the Gentle setting.
	<b>Do Not Tumble Dry</b>	A machine dryer may not be used. Usually accompanied by an alternate drying method symbol.
	<b>Do Not Dry</b>	A machine dryer may not be used. Usually accompanied by an alternate drying method symbol.
	<b>Line Dry</b>	Hang damp garment from line or bar, in or out doors.
	<b>Drip Dry</b>	Hang dripping wet garment from line or bar, in or out doors, without hand shaping or smoothing.
	<b>Dry Flat</b>	Lay out horizontally for drying.
	<b>Dry In Shade</b>	Usually added to Line or Drip Dry. Dry away from direct sunlight.
<b>Wring</b>		
	<b>Do Not Wring</b>	Do Not Wring.
<b>Iron</b>		
<small>NOTE: IF IRONING IS NOT A NECESSARY, REGULAR CARE PROCEDURE IT NEED NOT BE MENTIONED.</small>		
	<b>Iron, Any Temperature, Steam or Dry</b>	Regular ironing may be needed and may be performed at any available temperature with or without steam is acceptable.
	<b>Iron, Low</b>	Regular ironing, steam or dry, may be performed at Low setting (110C, 230F) only.
	<b>Iron, Medium</b>	Regular ironing, steam or dry, may be performed at Medium setting (150C, 300F).
	<b>Iron, High</b>	Regular ironing, steam or dry, may be performed at High setting (200C, 290F).
<small>NOTE: SYSTEM OF DOTS INDICATING TEMPERATURE RANGE IS THE SAME FOR ALL IRONING PROCEDURES.</small>		
	<b>Do Not Steam</b>	Steam ironing will harm garment, but regular dry ironing at indicated temperature setting is acceptable.
	<b>Do Not Iron</b>	Item may not be smoothed or finished with an iron.

## Dryclean

	<b>Dryclean</b>	Dry Clean, any solvent, any cycle any moisture, any heat.
	<b>Dryclean, Any Solvent</b>	Dry Clean, any solvent. Usually used with other restrictions on proper dry cleaning procedure.
	<b>Dryclean, Petroleum Solvent Only</b>	Dry Clean using only petroleum solvent. Usually used with other restrictions.
	<b>Dryclean, Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene</b>	Any dry cleaning solvent other than trichloroethylene may be safely used.
	<b>Dryclean, Short Cycle</b>	May be used with A, P, or F solvent restriction.
	<b>Dryclean, Reduced Moisture</b>	May be used with A, P, or F solvent restriction.
	<b>Dryclean, Low Heat</b>	May be used with A, P, or F solvent restriction.
	<b>Dryclean, No Steam</b>	May be used with A, P, or F solvent restriction.
	<b>Do Not Dryclean</b>	Garment may not be commercially drycleaned.
